



PARENT SUPPORT SERVICES SOCIETY OF BC

CONSTITUTION

1. NAME

The name of the Society shall be “PARENT SUPPORT SERVICES SOCIETY OF BC”.

2. OBJECTS

- (a) To support families to thrive;
- (b) To provide an organization in which anyone in a parenting role can receive support, education and resources in a safe, accepting, inclusive and respectful environment;
- (c) To educate the general public as to the importance of and strategies for the prevention of child abuse;
- (d) To recruit, train and support a cohort of volunteer facilitators who shall in turn support families within the stated values and guidelines of the Society;
- (e) To research and address issues that have an impact on the well being of families.

3. LOCATION

The operation of the Society will be carried on chiefly in the Province of British Columbia.
This provision may be altered.

4. The Society shall be carried on without purpose of gain for its members and any profits or other accretions to this Society shall be used in promoting its objects.

5. In the event of winding up or dissolution of the Society, any funds and assets of the Society remaining after the satisfaction of its debts and liabilities shall be given or transferred to such organization or organizations concerned with social problems or organizations promoting the same objects of this Society as may be determined by the members of this Society at the time of winding up or dissolution, but in the event that the foregoing provisions cannot be effected then such funds shall be given or transferred to some other organizations; provided that such organizations referred to in this paragraph shall be a charitable organization, a charitable corporation or a charitable trust recognized by the Department of National Revenue of Canada as being qualified as such under the provision of the Income Tax Act of Canada from time to time in effect.

6. Clauses 4 and 5 of this Constitution are unalterable in accordance with Section 17 of the Societies Act.
