Grandparents raising grandchildren & other kinship care families

This summer we are planning an overnight Nature Camp on Galiano Island, <u>July 31st, August 1st & 2nd, 2018</u> for a limited number of GRG families. Parent Support Services carries out fundraising in order to cover most of the costs including: Ferry, accommodations, food and activities for three days and two nights. Our partner, the Galiano Conservancy Association, has planned a wonderful program that engages the natural enthusiasm, curiosity and joy of everyone involved!

<u>Is this trip right for your family?</u> Here are some important details to help you decide:

 $\stackrel{(\otimes)}{\rightarrow}$ It is best suited for young children 5 years old and over and who are able to do well in a group setting

🤗 Grandparents are expected to participate with the children and are responsible for their grandchildren throughout

You will need to make your own way to the ferry terminal and pay for overnight parking <u>if required</u> and <u>bring a</u> <u>bagged lunch for the first day!</u>

On the day of departure if travelling from Vancouver Island you must be at the Swartz Bay ferry terminal no later than 10:00 am.

The return ferry to Swartz Bay leaves Galiano Island at 6:25 pm.

There is considerable time spent walking (sometimes on uneven terrain) during the Conservancy programming (all 3 days)

Scabins will be shared to allow as many families as possible to participate (families will not be separated)

🍀 Regardless of the weather conditions, swimming is <u>not</u> permitted during the trip due to the liability risk

Fires are also not permitted. The Bodega Ridge Lodge & the Learning Centre are both non- smoking facilities
