Bc211 Vancouver Island residents can dial 2-1-1 and speak to bc211 staff 24 hours a day, seven days a week to connect to community resources. Text service is also available throughout the Island, allowing residents to text the name of their city to 2-1-1 and connect with an information and referral specialist by text messaging. This service is available from 8 am to 11 pm, seven days a week.

Trained and certified bc211 information and referral specialists link people seeking assistance with a wide array of services such as addictions treatment, children's and youth programs, employment programs, food banks, legal aid, mental health supports, newcomer services, shelter and housing, and senior services. bc211 also helps service providers find resources for their clients and provides information for caregivers seeking help for their loved ones. <u>http://www.bc211.ca/</u>
