

MODERATE TO LOW-INCOME FAMILIES SEE A 10% INCREASE IN B.C. FAMILY BENEFIT FUND

Starting in July 2023 to June 2024, Moderate and low - income renters in B.C. will be eligible for a 10% increease in their monthly payments from the BC Family Benefit Fund. Single parents will receive as much as an additional \$500 per year on top of the 10% increase. Learn more here...



B.C ELIMINATES AGE RESTRICTION ON FREE TUITION FOR THOSE WHO WERE ONCE IN CARE

Effective August 2023, the B.C Government is opening its tuition waiver to all ages who were once in the Provincial foster care system. In previous years, the program only applied to individuals ages 19 to 26 who had been in care. To be eligible for the program, students must be registered full or part-time at one of B.C's public post secondary institutions, the Native Education College, or one of the 10 approved trades-training providers. Students can get up to \$3,500 a year to cover educational expenses such as textbooks and computers. This program is expected to support roughly 1200 students on top of the 1900 students that have had their tuition fees waived in previous years. **Learn more here...**
