



THE BIG PICTURE: An overview of the 2023 BC Adolescent Health Survey provincial results



MCCREARY CENTRE SOCIETY, 2024

Since 1992, the BC Adolescent Health Survey has been administered to young people throughout the Province to learn about the emerging health issues facing youth in our province. The 2023 BC AHS was completed by around 38,500 young people aged 12–19 in 59 of BC's 60 school districts. The survey was developed in consultation with young people, parents, and other experts in youth health. It was pilot-tested with diverse young people in communities across BC before being administered by Public Health Nurses and allied health professionals to students in mainstream public schools in the spring of 2023.

Results from the 2023 BC AHS paint a picture of what life is like for youth aged 12–19. The results provide data on youth home life, including living situations, Government care experience, parental monitoring. Data on housing, food security, mental health, school experiences, relationships and much more is also explored.

This report stands as an incredible testament to the resilience and perseverance of so many British Columbians who want to ensure they have up-to-date, accurate, and comprehensive data about the health of our young people, with which to make informed and evidence-based decisions.



VOLUNTEERING AT PSS PROVINCIAL TRAINING WORKSHOP MARCH 2024

On March 9th, 2024, PSS hosted the Provincial Training Workshop, held online for our volunteer facilitators and steering commitee members. Throughout the years, our Provincial Training Workshops have provided education and training to PSS volunteers on a variety of key topics relevant and necessary for facilitators. Last year, we addressed selfcompassion, trauma-informed practice, and had an introduction of the Parenting After Separation Course.



This year, apart from adressing the common challenges faced by our support groups and their facilitators, we committed to connecting with Indigneous communities in an effort to learn about Indigenous rights, history, treaties and the legacy of residential schools. PSS staff & volunteers were honoured to be joined by Elder Joe Wilson, who helped us deepen our understanding and learn about the impacts of colonization & residential schools through Elder Joe Wilson's personal story & experience. His workshop was titled **"Embracing the spirit of the Truth and Reconciliation's Calls to Action**".

The discussions during the round table session were highly productive and engaging, with facilitators actively sharing insights, experiences, and strategies related to various aspects of their roles. The workshop discussions focused on these main topics:

- 1. Strategies for managing group discussions when parents are raising neurodivergent children.
- 2. Addressing group challenges such as keeping meetings on time, ensuring equal participation, handling new referrals and changing attendance rates.
- 3. Tips for starting new support groups.
- 4. Challenges faced by facilitators

Apart from participating in discussion, the volunteers were able to engage in a Networking Session which gave them an opportunity to connect with other volunteers. PSS extends gratitude to Elder Joe Wilson for sharing his presence and impactful personal experience. Thank you volunteers for attending and contributing to the PTW. Your dedication to your groups, and enthusiasm for supporting parents and caregivers is truly commendable and serves as an motivation to us all. **Check out our volunteer recognition on the next page!**


