NEWS from the Ministry of Education and Child Care Families no longer charged fees for child care waitlists



(GOV.BC.CA)

Starting April 1, 2024, families seeking licensed child care won't face waitlist fees, easing the burden of finding quality care. Minister Mitzi Dean stated, "Eliminating these fees means families can save hundreds or even thousands of dollars."

Previously, about 5% of providers charged waitlist fees ranging from \$25 to \$200. This change ensures equitable access to child care, aligning with B.C.'s affordability programs, which have reduced daily costs from \$45 to \$18. The move has garnered support from parents like Gerónimo Ratcliffe and Rory Richards.

Notably, the Affordable Child Care Benefit (ACCB) supports low- to middle-income families, covering up to \$1,250 monthly per child. Visit www.gov.bc.ca/childcare for more information.

Expanded eligibility | New supports available for current, former youth in care

Starting April 4, 2024, over 9,000 current and former youth in care gain access to crucial financial, housing, educational, medical, and cultural supports through the Strengthening Abilities and Journeys of Empowerment (SAJE) program.



(GOV.BC.CA)

Eligibility expansion now includes young adults from all legal care statuses, offering a new unconditional income support of \$1,250 per month from age 19 to 20, with the option to extend until age 27 through eligible programming. These changes aim to prevent homelessness and poverty, providing stable housing and opportunities for success.


