

Looking for a Family Doctor?

All BC residents can now register for a family doctor or nurse practitioner in their community through BC's Health Connect Registry. When you register, you are added to a centralized registry of primary care providers across your community.



Registration takes less than 10 minutes. You need to provide:

- Personal Health Number (PHN), found on your BC Services Card
- Home address
- Email address and phone number





How to register in other languages

Call <u>8-1-1</u> to register for the Health Connect Registry in languages other than English. Translation services are available in over 130 languages.

After dialing 8-1-1, you will be connected with an English-speaking health service navigator. For service in another language, simply state the language (for example, say "Punjabi"), and an interpreter who speaks that language will join the call.
